## Psalm 31

# 1. Some Problems are of Our Own Making

Christians are not without sin

We are guilty but acquitted by God

-Psalm 31:10 "My life is consumed by anguish and my years by groaning; my strength fails because of my affliction,[a] and my bones grow weak." "my strength fails because of my guilt"

- "No one who lives in him keeps on sinning. No one who continues to sin has either seen him or known him." 1 John 3:6.
- It is only the grace of God that makes us different to those outside of Christ.

- We must look on the world that Jesus Christ came to save through His eyes
- We should be angry about sin, but we must see God's will is for the salvation of the sinner. If we love Jesus, then we must be obedient to His command to love sinners as He does.

- "I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent." Luke 15:7.
- There is no sin that cannot be forgiven except blaspheming the Holy Spirit

- We need to be more loving to, and tolerant of fellow believers who fall into sin.
- More time in prayer.
- More time telling others of their need and how much God loves them.

## 2. We can trust God to be God

"But I trust in you, LORD; I say, "You are my God." My times are in your hands: deliver me from the hands of my enemies from those who pursue me. Let your face shine on your servant; save me in your unfailing love. Let me not be put to shame, LORD, for I have cried out to you;"

- -King David found out, over and over again, that when everything looked impossible, and the world around him was falling apart, he had Someone he could trust to put things right
- Jesus wants us to have that child-like faith.

•vv 21-23 "Praise be to the LORD for he showed me the wonders of his love when I was in a city under siege. In my alarm I said, "I am cut off from your sight!" Yet you heard my cry for mercy when I called to you for help. Love the Lord all His faithful people!"
