"Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel." Isaiah 7:14


The Child King

Isaiah 9:6

For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

The Child King

- 4 names ...
- ★ Wonderful Counselor (Pele Yoeitz)
- ★ Mighty God (El Gibbor)
- ★ Everlasting Father (literally Eternal Father Avi Ad)
- ❖ Prince of Peace (Sar Shalom only name used for man and God)



Isaiah 9:7

He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever.

Messiah would have to come from...

- King David's own nation Israel
- King David's own tribe Judah
- King David's own family
- furthermore born in Bethlehem

Micah 5:2

"But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times."

Matthew 1:1

"A record of the genealogy of Jesus Christ the son of David, the son of Abraham"

Summary

We have biblically established that the Messiah must ...

- be a man born of a virgin
- be from the family of King David
- be from the Tribe of Judah
- ⇒ be born in Bethlehem in Israel
- be born before 70AD



Credentials of Rejection and Suffering

Isaiah 53 called "the Rabbis Conscience" for 2 reasons...

- Isaiah 53 not read in synagogues
- interpretation has been changed since11th Century Rabbi Rashi

Credentials of Rejection and Suffering

Isaiah 53:3

"He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering"



Credentials of Rejection and Isaiah 53:5-6 Suffering

But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.



Credentials of Rejection and Suffering

<u>Isaiah 53:11</u>

"After the suffering of his soul, he will see the light of life and be satisfied; by his knowledge my righteous servant will justify many, and he will bear their iniquities."

The Gospel of Messiah

"God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God." 2 Cor. 5:21

Summary of Credentials

Messiah had to ...

- Be a man born of a virgin.
- Be from the family of King David.
- Be from the Tribe of Judah.
- Be born in the town of Bethlehem in Israel.
- Be born before AD 70.

Summary of Credentials

- Be rejected and suffer for the sins of others
- Rise from the dead to ensure the forgiveness of sins

The Messianic Paradox

- seemingly contradictory prophecies about the Messiah
- Rabbi's solution 2 roles = 2 Messiahs
- Biblical solution one Messiah with 2 comings
